FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Los Angeles and Suburban Water Company, on June 11, 1928, filed its application as above entitled, for permission to issue \$1,502,600.00 of common capital stock, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, by Decision No. 20043, dated July 12, 1928, authorized the company to issue \$1,372,300.00 of stock, holding in abeyance the request so far as the remaining \$130,300.00 of stock was concerned until additional information had been submitted, and

WHEREAS, counsel for applicant during the hearing held on December 4, 1929 on Application No. 16054, involving, among other things, the transfer of applicant's properties to American States Water Service Company of California, stipulated that Application No. 14779 involving the issue of said \$130,300.00 of stock might be dismissed, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the request of Los Angeles and Suburban Water Company to issue \$130,300.00 of stock be, and it hereby is, dismissed.
