

Decision No. 22085.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the investigation upon the Commission's own motion into the rates, charges, classifications, rules, regulations, practices and contracts of SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA.

Case No. 2749.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS in Decision No. 21971, in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to schedules for surplus industrial service, that Southern Counties Gas Company of California should, within thirty (30) days from the date of that Order, file schedules calculated to reduce its 1930 revenue from this source by not less than \$14,400.00; and,

WHEREAS Southern Counties Gas Company of California has now filed schedules which, upon examination, appear properly designed to accomplish this purpose,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective for bills based on regular meter readings taken on and after February 10th, 1930, Southern Counties Gas Company of California shall charge and collect, for surplus industrial gas service now supplied

under corresponding schedules, the rates thus filed which are set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SCHEDULE NO. 1-D  
(Cancelling Schedule No. 1-D)

EASTERN DISTRICT

SURPLUS INDUSTRIAL SERVICE:

Applicable to industrial service on existing mains having a delivery capacity in excess of the present requirements of consumers served under Schedules Nos. 1-A, 1-A-L, 1-A-D, S-B and 1-C; for use in steam boilers, incinerators, kilns, or similar equipment, in which the gas is not used to heat buildings or to prepare meals, and whose times of maximum demand, if any, do not coincide with the maximum demand of consumers served under Schedules Nos. 1-A, 1-A-D, 1-A-L, S-B and 1-C.

35¢ per 1,000 cubic feet.

Subject to a change of 1/6 of one cent per thousand cubic feet for each change of 1 cent in the price of fuel oil above or below \$1.60 per barrel, as quoted by the Standard Oil Company, a California corporation; provided, however, that in every event this rate shall be limited to a minimum of 25 cents per thousand cubic feet and a maximum of 40 cents per thousand cubic feet.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

\$27.50 per consumer per month.

For continuous yearly service, accumulative annual minimum of \$330.00 per meter.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. This schedule is not applicable to bakeries, hot-houses, hotels, apartment houses, flats or residences.
2. Service is subject to discontinuance on thirty minutes notice in case of a shortage of gas.
3. Service to consumers served under Schedules Nos. 1-A, 1-A-D, 1-A-L, S-B and 1-C has precedence over this service in case of shortage of gas.

SCHEDULE NO. 1-D (Cont'd)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Cont'd):

4. In case of gas shortage, the higher rates have preference over the others.

5. In the application of this schedule, gas delivered to the various premises of a consumer cannot be aggregated.

SCHEDULE NO. 1-E

EASTERN DISTRICT

OIL FIELD SERVICE:

Applicable to service requiring the use of gas for pumping or drilling oil wells, or for other oil field operations.

TERRITORY:

Applicable to Eastern District, including all territory in Orange County, Whittier, Pomona and Monrovia Divisions.

RATE:

30¢ per 1,000 cubic feet.

Subject to a change of 1/6 of one cent per thousand cubic feet for each change of 1 cent in the price of fuel oil above or below \$1.60 per barrel, as quoted by the Standard Oil Company, a California corporation; provided, however, that in every event this rate shall be limited to a minimum of 20 cents per thousand cubic feet and a maximum of 35 cents per thousand cubic feet.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

\$50.00 per meter installation per month, or a cumulative minimum of \$600.00 per year. Minimum total use of gas at each meter installation - \$500.00.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

Character of Service:

Only surplus natural gas is available for consumers under this schedule. Consumers supplied under this schedule are subject to shut-off without notice in the event of a threatened or actual shortage of gas, and the Company will not be liable for damages occasioned by shutting off the gas supply.

For continuous yearly service, accumulative annual minimum of \$480.00 per consumer.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

1. This schedule is not applicable to bakeries, hothouses, hotels, apartment houses, flats or residences.
2. Service is subject to discontinuance on thirty minutes notice in case of a shortage of gas.
3. Service to consumers served under Schedules Nos. 5-A, 5-A-D and S-B has precedence over this service in case of shortage of gas.
4. In case of gas shortage, the higher rates have preference over the others.
5. A contract for a period of at least one year will be required as a condition precedent to service under this schedule.
