ORDER

This is an application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company for authority to abandon and discontinue the operation of a wharf on the Bay of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Applicant alleges that due to the expiration of its franchise and the refusal of the Board of State Harbor Commissioners for the Bay of San Diego to renew the same, that the operation of the wharf was discontinued in 1925; and that through inadvertence authority for the abandonment and discontinuance of the operation of the wharf was not at that time obtained from the Commission. Applicant therefore asks that the Commission at this time grant authority for said abandonment and discontinuance.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be, and it is hereby granted authority

to abandon and discontinue the operation of the wharf on the Bay of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, at the place and of the dimension as set forth and described in the franchise granted applicant by the Board of State Harbor Commissions of the Bay of San Diego, under date of August 1, 1905.
