ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company filed the above entitled application on the 13th day of January, 1930, seeking approval by the Commission of changes and improvements looking toward safe conditions at certain grade crossings in the City of Pasadena.

It appears that a joint inspection and study of all of the crossings over the main line of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Pasadena was made in April, 1928, by a committee composed of representatives of applicant, City of Pasadena, Automobile Club of Southern California and Engineering Department of the Railroad Commission and later inspection by the applicant and the City of Pasadena during October, 1929. As a result of these studies a report was prepared outlining certain improvements to be made by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and others by the City of Pasadena in accordance with the recommendations arrived at by the committee. In the instant application authority is sought to effect the major portion of

the improvements recommended by the said committee. The City of Pasadena has signified by letter that it is agreeable to the granting of this application. It appears to the Commission that the changes as outlined in said application are in the public interest and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant and City of Pasadena be and they are hereby authorized in so far as this Commission's authority is required to forthwith carry out the changes and improvements at grade crossings in the City of Pasadena as requested in said Application No. 16225, subject to such further order as circumstances may require.
