ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Fir on its Fernley-Lassen Branch, Salt Lake Division, in Lassen County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Fir during the annual period ending August 31, 1929; that no less than carload business was transacted at said station during said annual period; that no carload freight business was transacted at said station during the nine-month period ending August 31, 1929; that the principal shipper, Fruit Growers Supply Company, has discontinued operations at said station; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

Fruit Growers Supply Company has informed the Commission by letter that it does not object to the granting of the application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Fir, located on the Fernley-Lassen Branch of its Salt Lake Division, in Lassen County, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
