FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of Decision No. 12844, dated the 21st day of November, 1923, in this proceeding, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(3) A human flagman shall be maintained for the protection of said crossings between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 12:00 Midnight in the months of July to November, inclusive, each year and from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. in the months of December to June, inclusive, each year. The cost of said human flagman shall be borne by the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company."

In all other respects said Decision No. 12844 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
