

County Transportation Corporation, however, proposes to take over said lease, and to continue operation of the service. Said operation has been under his direction and supervision since 1927, and the assignment to him of the lease will enable him to continue said operation as an individual.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the assignment by Kern County Transportation Corporation to C. C. Haworth of the lease heretofore entered into by said corporation and Pickwick Stages System, as approved by Railroad Commission Decision No. 18092, be and the same is hereby approved, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Kern County Transportation Corporation, C. C. Haworth and Pickwick Stages System file with the Railroad Commission such tariffs and time schedules as are necessary to cover the operating changes herein authorized.
