ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, C. M. Falconer, to whom this Commission by Decision No. 22064, dated January 30, 1930, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger stage service between San Fernando and Granada and intermediate points, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of February 18, 1930, that he does not choose to accept said certificate because sub-division promoters, whose property he proposed to serve, had declined to subsidize the service.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said C.M. Falconer by said Decision No. 22064 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.
