Grant Moffet, doing business under the fictitious name and style of Downey Home Tract Water Works, having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer his public utility water system supplying water to the residents of a portion of the unincorporated Town of Downey in Los Angeles County to the Downey County Water District, which joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the authority should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Grant Moffet, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of Downey Home Tract Water Works, be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to the Downey County Water District, a corporation, his public utility water system supplying consumers residing in a certain section of the Town of Downey, Los Angeles County, under substantially the same terms and conditions as set out in Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of June, 1930, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Grant Moffet within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
- 2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Grant Moffet actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
- 3. On or before the first day of May, 1930, Grant Moffet shall refund to all his water consumers entitled thereto all amounts due such consumers arising from deposits made to guarantee payment of water bills, or for main extensions, meter and/or service connections, and/or any other purpose whatsoever, and said Grant Moffet shall file with this Commission on or before the first day of May, 1930, a duly executed affidavit setting forth a list of all consumers to whom refunds, as set forth above, are due as of the date of this order, together with the amount of each refund and the date that each such refund has been fully paid to the consumer entitled thereto. In the event that there are no consumers entitled to refunds as set out above, the affidavit should so state.

The authority herein granted shall become effective only upon full compliance by Grant Moffet with the terms and conditions as set forth in the above paragraphs.
