BY THE COMMISSION:

PRELIMINARY ORDER

Mt. Tamalpais and Muir Woods Railway, applicant herein, requests permission to continue the suspension of operations of its railroad up to and including April 30th of each year. By Decision No. 4927, dated December 6th, 1917, in Application No. 3272, authority was granted to suspend service during the months of November, December, January and February of each year. By the instant request, applicant seeks authority to continue the suspension of operations to and including April 30th, 1930. It appears that there is certain opposition to the granting of the application and that the proceeding should be set for public hearing before entering a final decision in the matter; however, it appears reasonable to grant applicant authority to continue the suspension of operations now in effect until and including March 15th, 1930; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mt. Tamalpais and Muir Woods Railway be and it is hereby authorized to continue the suspension

of service on its Mountain Division from Mill Valley to the summit of Mt. Tamalpais, including the Muir Woods Branch, until and including March 15th, 1930.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
