FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Napa Milling and Warehouse Co., operator of an
automotive trucking service between Napa and Napa Soda Springs
under authority of a certificate of public convenience and neces-
sity, acquired by Railroad Commission Decision No. 21176, has re-
quested, in writing, under date of March 10, 1930, that said
certificate be revoked, and

WHEREAS, said Napa Milling and Warehouse Co., has further
advised that because said Napa Soda Springs is now shipping its
products under private arrangement, operation of the service
performed by said Napa Milling and Warehouse Co. cannot be main-
tained at a profit, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
and necessity heretofore acquired by Napa Milling and Warehouse Co.,
under Decision No. 21176 be and the same is hereby revoked and
annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time
schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said Napa Milling
and Warehouse Co. be and the same are hereby canceled.
