ORDER

Railway Express Agency, Inc., has filed with the Commission an application for authority to abandon its free collection and delivery service at Lakeport, Lake County, California, as defined in the California Section of Joint Directory of Collection and Delivery Limits, Cal. R. C. No. 5.

Applicant alleges that this authority is requested to enable it to correct its tariff and that it will result in no actual diminution in the service now rendered, due to the fact that said free delivery and collection service was actually discontinued December 1, 1913, but has been erroneously listed in its tariff since that date.

It appears to this Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Inc., to abandon its free collection and delivery service at Lakeport, Lake County, California, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission collection and delivery limits at Lakeport, California, as shown in California Section of Joint Directory of collection and delivery limits, Cal. R. C. No. 5.
