FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requirement for protection as set forth in Condition (3) of the Commission's Order in its Decision No. 21771, dated November 7, 1929, in the above entitled proceeding, be and it is hereby suspended, insofar as it pertains to the side track, located fifteen (15) feet northeasterly from the center line of the existing main track, and described as Track No. 1 in said decision, until such time as this, or a substitute track, becomes a part of the main line track or until further order of this Commission.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 21771, heretofore rendered in this proceeding, shall remain

in full force and effect.
