ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on March 12, 1930, asking for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a combination passenger and freight building at its non-agency station of Pitt, in the County of Shasta, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said station of Pitt was discontinued as an agency station during January of 1928, and that the business of said station of Pitt does not, in its opinion, warrant the continued maintenance of said building.

It appears to this Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its combination passenger and freight

building, located at its non-agency station of Pitt in the
County of Shasta, State of California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective
on the date hereof.
