In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Melitta, in Sonoma County, California.

**ORIGINAL**ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on April 4, 1930, asking for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Melitta in Sonoma County, California.

Applicant alleges that passenger service is no longer operated on its Santa Rosa Branch, on which branch said passenger shelter shed is located, and that in its opinion said passenger shed is not now necessary nor likely to be required in the future for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove the passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Melitta in Sonoma County, California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective

on the date hereof.
