In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Union in Napa County, California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Union on the Napa Branch of its Western Division in Napa County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that it no longer operates passenger trains on its Napa Branch and that said passenger shelter shed is not now necessary nor likely to be required in the future; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said passenger shelter shed is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Union, located on the Napa Branch of its Western Division in Napa County.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
