ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Baku on the Santa Rosa Branch of its Western Division in Sonoma County and at the location as shown in yellow on a blue-print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that it no longer operates passenger trains on its Santa Rosa Branch and that said passenger shelter shed is not now necessary nor likely to be required in the future and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said passenger shelter shed is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its passenger shelter shed at its non-agency station of Baku, located on the Santa Rosa Branch of its Western Division in Sonoma County.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
