ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a portion of a team track located at Santa Clara, in Santa Clara County, as shown in yellow on a blue-print map (Coast Division Drawing 23713) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the track herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is constructed in a public street known as Sherman Street; that residents living on said street have petitioned applicant to remove said track; and, that said track is not needed or likely to be needed in the future as the business handled on this track can be readily handled on other existing tracks of applicant.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove that portion of its team track located in Sherman Street, in the City of Santa Clara, County of Santa Clara, State of California, and as more definitely shown in yellow on map attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
