ORDER GRANTING CONSENT TO  
EXTEND TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE.

By its verified petition, The Farmers Canal Company, a corporation, prays that the Railroad Commission give its consent to the extension of its corporate existence for the period to and including April 1, 1980. It appears from the petition that applicant's corporate existence will determine and expire on May 8, 1930. It further appears that its Board of Directors has determined that it is for the best interests of the corporation that its term of existence be extended for the period to and including April 1, 1980. The consent of this Commission to such extension is required under the provisions of Section 401 of the Civil Code.

It appearing that such consent should be given, and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA that consent be, and is hereby, given to The Farmers Canal Company to extend the term of its corporate existence for the period to and including April 1, 1930.
