In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at non-agency station of Agua Caliente in the County of Sonoma, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at the non-agency station of Agua Caliente on its Santa Rosa Branch, Western Division, in Sonoma County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the passenger shelter shed herein proposed to be abandoned is not now necessary nor likely to be required in the future, as applicant no longer operates passenger trains on said Santa Rosa Branch, and that there was no passenger business transacted at said non-agency station for the year ended December 31, 1929.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its passenger shelter shed located at the non-agency station of Agua Caliente on its Santa Rosa Branch, Western Division, in Sonoma County, and as more definitely shown in yellow on map attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
