BY THE COMMISSION -

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause therefore appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following condition be
 substituted for Condition No.1 contained in Decision No.22274:

1- That no service shall be given between intermediate points between San Francisco and Los Angeles nor between the terminals and intermediate points and that Sunberg shall not accept for transportation commodities requiring refrigeration, fresh vegetables or cut flowers or second-hand household goods, office furniture, fixtures and equipment, musical instruments, radios and other second-hand household equipment not boxed or crated; also barrels, bundles and boxes containing second-hand household goods, but not including baggage, trunks, traveling cases, suitcases, cartons or boxes containing personal effects.

In all other respects Decision No.22274 and the order contained therein are to remain unchanged.
