FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 20830, dated March 2, 1929, established rates to be charged by the Oakdale Gas Company and provided that such rates would upon order of the Railroad Commission be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$1.1825 per barrel in Oakdale, and further provided that no increase shall be made after the price of oil f.o.b. Oakdale passes \$2.40 per barrel; and

WHEREAS, Oakdale Gas Company now makes affidavit that on March 11, 1930, the price paid for oil was increased to \$1.2159 per barrel which price is three (3) cents per barrel more than the basic price upon which rates were established in Decision No. 20830.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Oakdale Gas Company be and it is authorized to increase its present rates, designated as Schedule No. 1, for all meter readings taken on and after May

1, 1930, so that said rates shall be equal to one (1) cent more than the basic rates established in Decision No. 20830.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Oakdale Gas Company, if it elects to exercise this privilege, file with the Commission on or before May 1, 1930, a revision of its rates as herein authorized.
