FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Marshall Dunkum, to whom this Commission, in its Decision No.11065, dated October 7, 1922, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Placerville and Cool, has requested authority to discontinue said service, and

WHEREAS in a sworn statement filed with this Commission by said Marshall Dunkum he shows that the total revenue from the service for the six months preceding said request for authority to discontinue totaled \$123.70 with expenses of \$107.07, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said Marshall Dunkum be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue said service between Placerville and Cool, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Marshall Dunkum by said Decision No.11065 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules covering said service , filed with the Railroad Commission by said Dunkum, be and the same are hereby canceled.
