SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

OBINION

In Decision No. 22130, dated February 15, 1930, this Commission made its Order declaring that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Southern California Gas Company of the rights and privileges granted by franchise applied for to the City of Corcoran, County of Kings, in so far as the exercise of such franchise is necessary for the distribution and sale of natural gas in said city. Such certificate was made contingent upon the following conditions:

- "(a) That Southern California Gas Company shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the franchise to be granted to it by the City of Corcoran.
 - (b) That Southern California Gas Company shall file with this Commission a stipulation, duly executed on authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that it will never claim for said franchise a value in excess of the cost thereof.
 - (c) Upon the filing of the franchise and stipulation, referred to in Conditions (a) and (b) above, in the proper form, the Commission will issue its supplemental order authorizing the exercise of the rights conferred by such franchise.

(d) Said franchise and stipulation shall be filed on or before April 30, 1930.

In conformity with the above, Southern California Gas Company has now filed a certified copy of franchise granted to it by the City of Corcoran (Ordinance No. 43 N.S.) and stipulation as to the value thereof both in proper form.

ORDER

Southern California Cas Company having applied to the Railroad Commission of the State of California for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity requires and will require the exercise by applicant of rights and privileges granted to it by Ordinance No. 43 N.S. of the City of Corcoran,

The Reilroad Commission of the State of California bereby declares that public convenience and necessity requires and will require the exercise by Southern California Cas Company of the rights and privileges granted under Ordinance No. 43 N.S. of the City of Corcoran in so far as such exercise is necessary for the distribution and sale of natural gas in said city.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
