FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission, by its Decision No. 22175 dated the twenty-seventh day of February, 1930, authorized Grant Moffet, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of Downey Hometract Water Works, to transfer to Downey County Water District, a corporation, a public utility water system supplying consumers residing in a certain section of the Town of Downey in accordance with certain terms and conditions, one of which required the making of refunds by said Grant Moffet to all consumers entitled thereto for deposits made to guarantee the payment of water bills, main extensions, etc. The provisions of said order relating to said refunds have been satisfactorily complied with. The purchaser now makes request that Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the said order be modified and, it appearing that said request may properly be granted, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Commission's Decision No. 22175 be and they are hereby modified to read as follows:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been

made on or before the first day of June, 1930, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Grant Moffet, or by Downey County Water District, a corporation, or in their behalf, or in behalf of either thereof, within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Grant Moffet actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, there shall be filed with this Commission by Grant Moffet, or by Downey County Water District, a corporation, or in their behalf, or in behalf of either thereof, a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.

The authority herein granted shall become effective only upon full compliance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the above paragraphs.

In all other respects, said Decision No. 22175 dated February 27, 1930, shall remain in full force and effect.
