ORDER

Della M. Gidley having made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer her public utility water system supplying water to the residents of Tract No. 7007, Los Angeles County, to T.B. Henley, who joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the authority should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Della M. Gidley be and she is hereby authorized to transfer to T.B. Henley her public utility water system supplying consumers residing in Tract No. 7007, Los Angeles County, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of August, 1930, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Della M. Gidley within thirty (30) days from the date upon which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Della M. Gidley actually relinquishes control and possession of the property

herein authorized to be transferred, she shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.

3. On or before the first day of June, 1930, Della M. Gidley shall refund to all of her water consumers entitled thereto all amounts due such consumers arising from deposits made to guarantee payment of water bills or main extensions, meter and/or service connections, and/or any other purpose whatsoever, and Della M. Gidley shall file with this Commission, on or before the first day of June, 1930, a duly executed affidavit setting forth a list of all consumers to whom refunds, as set forth above, are due as of the date of this order, together with the amount of each refund and the date that each such refund has been fully paid to the consumer entitled thereto. In the event that there are no consumers entitled to refunds as set out above, the affidavit should so state.

The authority herein granted shall become effective only upon full compliance by Della M. Gidley with the terms and conditions of Paragraph 3 of this order.
