BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of the RAILWAY EXPRESS AGENCY, INC., for authority to abandon its agency at Vallejo Junction, County of Contra Costa, State of California.

ORDER

Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency station of Vallejo Junction on the main line of Southern Pacific Company in Contra Costa County.

Applicant alleges that said station of Vallejo Junction was used as a transfer point for express shipments to Vallejo; that since the abandonment of ferry boat service between Vallejo Junction and Vallejo by Southern Pacific Company, express shipments are handled by bus from the station of Crockett; and, that the maintenance of an agency at the station of Vallejo Junction is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Vallejo Junction, located on the main line of Southern Pacific Company, in Contra

Costa County, provided, however, that express shipments will be delivered or received by express messenger from the car door on trains stopping at said station of Vallejo Junction.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
