In the Matter of the Application of Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to exercise certain rights and permits under a franchise which it contemplates securing from the Town of Walnut Creek, and authorizing it further to exercise the rights and privileges granted under Ordinance No. 130 of the County of Contra Costa which have not heretofore been authorized to be exercised by the Railroad Commission of the State of California.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In its Decision No. 22263, dated March 29, 1930, this Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Coast Counties Cas and Electric Company, authorizing applicant to construct and operate the natural gas transmission and distribution system referred to therein and to exercise the rights and privileges of the franchise granted to applicant under Ordinance No. 130 of the County of Contra Costa and under the franchise which applicant contemplates securing from the Town of Walnut Creek, insofar as both of these franchises are necessary to the construction, maintenance and use of the specific project therein mentioned, subject to certain conditions among which were the following:

"(1) That Coast Counties Cas and Electric Company shall file with this Commission certified copies of the franchises from the Town of Walnut Creek, and of the franchise granted to applicant under Ordinance No. 130 of the County of Contra Costa.

That Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company shall file with this Commission stipulations duly executed on authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that applicant, its successors or assigns will never claim a value for these franchises in excess of the original cost thereof. "(3) Upon the filing of the franchises and stipulations referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) in the proper form, this Commission will issue its supplemental order, authorizing the exercise of the rights and privileges conferred by such franchises. Said franchises and stipulations shall be filed on or before April 30, 1930.7 Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company now having filed with this Commission a certified copy of franchise granted to it under Ordinance No. 55-B of the City of Walnut Creek, and a certified copy of resolution duly executed on authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that applicant will never claim a value for said franchise in excess of Two hundred Ninety-two (292.50) Dollars and Fifty Cents, the actual cost thereof, both in proper form, the Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby orders that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby granted to Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company, authorizing applicant to exercise the rights and privileges granted by such franchise. The authority herein granted shall be effective from and after the date of this order.
