ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Brightside and of a shelter shed at said station on its Western Division in Alameda County, and shown in yellow on a blue print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted at the non-agency station of Brightside during the annual period ending November 30, 1929 and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station and shelter shed is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation,

to abandon its non-agency station of Brightside and the passenger shelter shed located thereat on its Western Division in Alameda County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and to cancel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said non-agency station.
