FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission on March 19, 1930, issued its Decision No. 22228 in the above entitled proceedings, establishing a schedule of rates to be charged by The San Joaquín and Kings River Canal and Irrigation Company for irrigation and other purposes. In order to make more definite and certain the period of use and the charges applicable to water furnished for grain and pasture demands, it appears reasonable and proper at this time to modify said schedule of rates as to this class of service.

Good cause therefor appearing,

IT IS HERMEY OFDERED that so much of the order in said Decision No. 22228 as reads as follows:

"IRRIGATION SERVICE - FLAT RATES Grain Crops For irrigation of grain other than rice-\$1.50 per acre per season; 75¢ per acre to accompany application and balance payable on or before April 1st. When additional irrigations are required for second croppings of grain land, 75¢ per acroper irrigation, payable before each irrigation. IRRIGATION SERVICE - MEASURED RATES Grain Crops For the irrigation of grain other than rice, a payment of 75¢ per acre to accompany application; balance payable on or before June 1st. When additional irrigations are required for second croppings of grain land, a payment of 75¢ per acre to accompany application therefor; balance payable on or before thirty (30) days after completion of said service," be and it is hereby modified and amended to read as follows: TRRIGATION SERVICE - FLAT RATES Grain Crops and Pasture For the irrigation of pasture and grain other than rice irrigated from October 1st to April 15th, inclusive, of the immediately succoeding year-\$1.50 per acre per season; 75¢ per acre to accompany application and balance payable on or before June 1st. When additional irrigations are required for second croppings of grain or pasture lands, 75¢ per acre per irrigation, payable before each irrigation. IRRIGATION SERVICE - MEASURED RATES Grain Crops and Pasture For the irrigation of pasture and grain other than rice irrigated from October 1st to April 15th, inclusive, of the immediately succeeding year, a payment of 75¢ per acre to accompany application; balance payable on or before June 1st. -2GEE

When additional irrigations are required for second croppings of grain or pasture lands, a payment of 75¢ per acre to accompany application therefor; balance payable on or before thirty (30) days after completion of said service.

In all other respects said Decision No. 22228 dated March 19, 1930, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified herein.

The effective date of this supplemental order shall be as of the date hereof.
