ORDER

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 8th day of May, 1930, asking for authority to abandon and remove its freight station building at the non-agency station of Ross in Marin County and to cancel all L.C.L. freight tariffs from and to said station.

The City Council of said city has signified by Resolution No. 130, dated April 10, 1930, and principal receivers and shippers of freight have signified by letter that they consent to the granting of this application.

It appears to this Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company
