ORDER REVOKING CONDITION IN PRIOR ORDER

Key System Transit Company having in Application No. 16534 requested permission to operate its trains on Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, across Addison Street, and the City of Berkeley having by letter requested that said permission be granted and it appearing to the Commission that Condition (6) of its Decision No. 15634, dated November 13, 1925, which provides for the elimination of all southbound movements of interurban trains by Key System Transit Company across Addison Street, should be revoked, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (6) of Decision No. 15634, dated November 13, 1925, be and it is hereby revoked.

In all other respects this Commission's decisions in the above entitled matter shall remain in full force and effect.
