FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 21,756 dated November 5, 1929, in this proceeding, be revoked and annulled and the following order substituted in its stead:

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company and the City and County of San Francisco be and they are hereby authorized to widen the crossing of Sickles Avenue (designated as No. EM-6.28) approximately thirty (30) feet, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The cost of widening said Crossing No. EM-6.28 shall be borne in accordance with an agreement between the interested parties.

(2) Said crossing shall be constructed substantially in accordance with Standard No. 3 or Standard No. 4, as shown by General Order No. 72 of this Commission, and of a width to

conform to the pavement of Sickles Avenue.

(3) Applicant, Southern Pacific Company, is authorized to remove the crossing gates, as shown in yellow on Blue Print Drawing A-87.93, attached to the application.

(4) All switching movements over the highway shall be preceded by a member of the train crew acting as human flagman.

(5) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossing.

(6) If said crossing shall not have been installed within one year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

(7) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
