SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In its Decision No. 22423, dated May 13, 1930, this Commission granted the certificate of public convenience and necessity to Southern California Gas Company, authorizing applicant to exercise the franchise rights under franchise which it contemplated securing from the City of Delano, County of Kern, covering the distribution and sale of gas in that city.

The certification made therein was granted subject to the following conditions:

"(1) That on or before May 31, 1930, applicant, Southern California Gas Company, shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the franchise in question.

(2) That on or before May 31, 1930, applicant, Southern California Gas Company, shall file with this Commission a stipulation duly executed upon authority of its Board of Directors, agreeing that applicant, its successors, or assigns, will never claim a value for such franchise in excess of the cost thereof.

(3) That upon the filing by applicant of the franchise and stipulation referred to in (1) and (2) above, in the proper form, this Commission will issue a supplemental order authorizing
