SUPPLEMENTAL FIFTH INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Under date of May 23, 1930, this Commission issued its Fifth Interlocutory Order in the above matters, the same being denominated Decision 32471. By said order The Southern Sierras Power Company was authorized to place in effect upon its system on June 1, 1930, a certain territorial map described as "Map of Territory 'B'-C.R.C. Sheet No. 571-E", and a rate schedule numbered and entitled "Schedule P 2- C.R.C. Sheet No. 572-E".

It appears that the said rate schedule was incorrectly described and should have been referred to as


"Schedule P 32 - C.R.C. Sheet No. 572-E". This correction will be made in this supplemental order.

The Southern Sierras Power Company has requested that the said territorial map and rate schedule be made effective on May 1, 1930, instead of June 1, 1930. The new schedule results in a decrease in rates, and it appears to be in the public interest that the request be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Commission Decision Number 32471 be and the same is hereby amended in two particulars: (1) the rate schedule therein approved and ordered filed is hereby described as "Schedule P 32 - C.R.C. Sheet No. 572-E", rather than "Schedule P 2 - C.R.C. Sheet No. 572-E", and (2) the territorial map and rate schedule therein approved and ordered filed is made effective on May 1, 1930, rather than on June 1, 1930.

In all other respects the said Commission Decision Number 32471 is affirmed.
