Good Cause Appearing:

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

HEREBY DECLARES that Consumers Gas Company has filed with the
 Railroad Commission in satisfactory form stipulations duly authorized
 by its Board of Directors declaring that it, its successors and assigns
 will never claim before the Railroad Commission, or any court or other
 public body, a value for the rights and privileges granted by Ordinance
 No. 130 passed by the City Council of the City of Los Banos on
 April 17, 1929, for the rights and privileges granted by Ordinance No.
 52 passed by the City Council of the City of Gustine on May 13, 1929,
 and for the rights and privileges granted by Ordinance No. 180, passed
 by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Merced on July 2, 1929,

in excess of the amounts actually paid as the consideration for the granting of said rights and privileges, which are \$234.65, \$191.50 and \$379.50 respectively.
