

Decision No. 22520.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed at non-agency station of Tarn in the County of Fresno, State of California.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger shelter shed located at its non-agency station of Tarn on its San Joaquin Division in Fresno County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (San Joaquin Division Drawing A-3966) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that passenger business to amount of \$14.00 was transacted at the non-agency station of Tarn during the annual period ending January 31, 1930; that said passenger business does not justify the maintenance of said passenger shelter shed; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said passenger shelter shed is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its passenger shelter shed located at its non-agency station of Tarr, on its San Joaquin Division in Fresno County.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
