ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a portion of a team track at Ben Lomond, in Santa Cruz County, and shown in yellow on a blue print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the portion of track herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is constructed in public street; that the abandonment and removal of said portion of the team track will not impair applicant's service to the public at said Ben Lomond and that said portion of the team track is not now needed nor, in the opinion of applicant, likely to be needed in the future.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the

application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its team track located at Ben Lomond, in Santa Cruz County, and as more definitely shown in yellow on map (Coast Division Drawing No. 24074) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
