IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operating right for said service heretofore acquired by said H.G. Ray under authority of Decision No. 19517, dated March 22, 1928, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules covering said service filed with the Railroad Commission by said H.G. Ray be and the same are hereby canceled.
