O R D E R

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, filed the above mentioned application with this Commission on May 15th, 1930, asking for authority to cancel all less than carload freight tariffs to and from the non-agency station of Donahue, in the County of Sonoma, California, and to discontinue the receipt or delivery of less than carload freight thereat.

Applicant alleges that it is no longer necessary or desirable to continue to publish said Donahue as a less than carload station as the amount of that class of business is negligible.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified by letter that it will offer no objection to the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all less than carload freight tariffs applying to the station of Donahue, County of Sonoma, California, and to discontinue the receipt or delivery of less than carload freight thereat.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
