Penny Newman Grain Company, a co-partnership, consisting of M.A. Penny and D. L. Newman.

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Kutner Goldstein Company and Penny Newman Grain
 Company shall join in common supplement to the
 tariffs now on file in the name of Kutner Goldstein Company, the former withdrawing and the
 latter adopting such tariffs and all effective
 supplements thereto.
- 2. The authority herein granted will become effective five days after the date hereof.
