ORDER

Semper & Ham having asked permission to lease for a term of one year beginning June 1, 1930, their warehouse known as the Semper & Ham Warehouse at Euron, California, to H. S. Brietegam for the consideration of \$500.00, and H. S. Brietegam having asked permission to lease the same and use it for the storage of grain, and the Commission having considered the request of applicants and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary in this matter and that this application should be granted as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Semper & Ham be, and they are hereby, authorized to lease their warehouse known as the Semper & Ham Warehouse in Euron, California, to H. S. Brietegam, provided that said Semper & Ham and said H. S. Brietegam shall join in a common supplement to the tariffs now on file in the name of Semper & Ham, the former withdrawing and the latter adopting such

tariffs and all effective supplements thereto.
