OPINION AND ORDER

In this application, applicant, Natural Gas Corporation of California, Ltd., has asked this Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to exercise rights and privileges under franchises which it contemplates securing from certain cities, towns and counties, including Lancaster, Los Angeles County, and for authority to install plants and distribute liquefied natural gas therein.

Applicant now no longer contemplates service in Lancaster and asks that its application for that particular town be dismissed; therefore,

Natural Gas Corporation of California, Ltd., having asked that its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to exercise franchise rights and supply liquefied natural gas in the town of Lancaster, Los Angeles County, be dismissed, and

Good cause appearing,
