ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The above entitled application was filed on February 26, 1930, and was set for public hearing on March 20, 1930, before Examiner Gannon at Los Angeles. Testimony taken at that time indicated that the applicant proposed to obtain its water supply from the municipal water system of the City of Los Angeles and re-distribute same to its consumers occupying land above the level reached by the municipal system. The charter of the City of Los Angeles prohibits the sale of water for re-distribution by its Department of Water and Power as proposed by applicant.

Upon motion of applicant the hearing was continued to a later date to permit the company to negotiate with the City of Los Angeles to supply the tract with water. For the same reason, the matter was again continued, and at the final hearing held on June 18, 1930, applicant failed to make any appearance

at all. It appears, therefore, that the application should be dismissed for want of procecution, therefore

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
