## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, White Brothers, to whom this Commission by its Decision No.18387, amended by Decision No.19468, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto service between Jackson and Volcano have advised the Commission, in writing, under date of July 3, 1930, that because of the loss of a mail contract with the U.S. Covernment they cannot continue to operate said service, the revenue from the transportation of persons and property being insufficient to meet cost of operation, and

WHEREAS, said White Brothers have requested that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore acquired by them under said Decision No.18387, as amended, be revoked and annulled, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules filed by said White Brothers covering said service be and the same are hereby canceled.
