BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission having on September 20, 1928, in its Decision No. 20234 in the above entitled application, authorized the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, to construct a public road at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the vicinity of Soda Springs Station, said crossing not having been constructed within the limit of time fixed in said Decision No. 20234 and subsequent orders in this proceeding and said authority having, therefore, lapsed; the Board of Supervisors, on June 11, 1930, having filed a supplemental application in this proceeding, requesting that the Commission renew the authority previously granted on the same terms and conditions and it appearing that conditions in the vicinity of the proposed crossing are substantially the same as at the time the Commission made its former decision and that

this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary,
therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority
be and it is hereby granted to the Board of Supervisors of the
County of Nevada, State of California, to construct a public
road at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company at
a point approximately 400 feet east of Soda Springs station
building as now located, subject to the same terms and conditions
as set forth in Decision No. 20234, dated September 20, 1928.

The effective date of this order shall be the date
hereof.
