O R D E R

Indian Valley Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Engels, County of Plumas, State of California.

Applicant alleges that the Engels Copper Mining Company has closed down its plant indefinitely and that practically all of the business in and out of the station of Engels is that of the Engels Copper Mining Company and that consequently there will not be sufficient business to justify the maintenance of said agency.

It appears to the Commission that the continued maintenance of the agency at said station of Engels is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is granted to Indian Valley Railroad Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the Station of Engels, County of

Plumas, State of California, and to eliminate said agency name from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
