BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, filed with this Commission the above numbered application, asking authority to abandon and remove its freight platform at the station of Laguna, on its Whittier Line in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that owing to the small amount of freight business handled at this station, the said freight platform is no longer necessary and that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of said freight platform.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company to abandon and remove its freight platform at the station of Laguna, on its Whittier Line in the County of Los Angeles, all of which is shown by the map attached to the application (Drawing No. C.E.H. 12511), provided, however, that no other facilities shall be removed from

said station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
