BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 24th day of June, 1930, asking for authority to construct a public highway under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company at Newcastle, Placer County, as hereinafter set forth. Applicant has agreed to bear the entire cost of the work.

It appears to the Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary and that it is to the interests of public convenience and necessity that the crossing be constructed and that this application should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter specified, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the People of the State of

California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, be and they are hereby authorized to construct a crossing under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in the vicinity of Newcastle, Placer County, substantially in accordance with the plan attached to the application. Said crossing is identified as Crossing No. A-120.2-B and shall be constructed subject to the following conditions:

(1) Cost of construction of said undergrade crossing shall be borne by the applicant.

(2) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossing.

(3) If said crossing shall not have been installed within one year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

(4) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
