FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company and The Pacific Lumber Company have filed a supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding requesting authority to execute an additional agreement covering the joint use by applicants of the line of railroad belonging to applicant, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, between Scotia and South Bay in Humboldt County, said agreement permitting the transportation of logs by The Pacific Lumber Company over said line of railroad.
